Report on trade: A good entry of stock found buyers generally a little more cautious than in recent sales but that said the better bred stronger cattle for sale found strong demand and produced some very good prices. Highlights were 2 bulls sold at 3,000 and 3,200gns for Trottenden Poll Wellington 3rd from C E & W S Millson, Goudhurst and Mayfield General 4th born in 2010 from Mr D A Innes, Titsey Estate, Oxted; 7 in calf heifers, all bred from polled stock, from F A Starley, Henfield making to 1500 gns and averaging 1185gns; 2 maiden heifers from Chandler and Dunn's Goldstone herd which made 1600 and 1450gns; a pure cow and calf, Rugmer Hill Cyclamen 8th born in 2011 with her bull calf from M Gibb 1380 gns and J King and Son sold Trottenden Poll Terpsichore 3rd born in 2012 with her heifer calf for 1480 gns

In the judging ring Ralph Sheppard choose C E & W S Millsons bull as champion which was purchased by the Royal Farms with Mr D A Innes senior bull reserve purchased by Sutton Estates, Benham, Newbury. In the female classes best in calf pair were from the Starley (Edburton herd) consignment and purchased by Jane Howard, Wadhurst and David and Julie Murray, Otterden. The maidens prize went to Chandler and Dunn and both were purchased by Ian and Kathryn Hutchinson, Malton Yorkshire. Individual female champion and reserve were one from the Chandler and Dunn pen and then a B W Kemsley and Son, Barming heifer, Aylesford Snowdrop 11th , purchased again by the Hutchinsons.

Mature females offered included 5 draft consignments of cows and calves 3 of which averaged over 1000gns from S & N Bish, Buxted whose 4 averaged 1130gns, M Gibbs 4 homebred pure (*) couples which averaged 1077 gns and J King and Sons 4 averaged 1095 gns. Away from the youngest and stronger cows the reat made 880 to 980 gns.

15 out of 40 in calf heifers sold made over 1000gns and 15 individuals purchased from this section. The 1500 gns top call was paid for Elburton Poll Bree 1st purchased by Mrs Jane Howard.

The Hutchinsons also purchased another Aylesford bred heifer from B W Kemsley and Son for 1220 gns and then L Stevens and Sons, Sittingbourne 2 heifers for 1180 and 1140 gns.

Averages: 22 cows and calves 1020 gns; 7 in calf cows 772 gns; 2 bulls 3100 gns; 40 in calf heifers 916 gns and 28 maiden heifers 765 gns
