

SUSSEX CATTLE SOCIETY

Judges Panel Criteria Applicable from 1st January 2025

JUDGES CLASSIFICATIONS/SELECTION

All entries/classifications on the Judges List will be made and approved by the Sussex Cattle Society Council.

The Council will recommend to shows a judge for the Sussex Classes but it is noted that shows may select their own judge from the Society List or from outside the breed. The Society reserves the right to remove Judges from the panel if they are no longer involved with the breed.

SENIOR/INTERBREED JUDGES

To have already judged at higher county shows on more than one occasion, Sussex and/or Interbreed classes [historical appointments applied].

To have judged at least 3 shows and the Herd Competition on at least 4 occasions.

EMERITUS [PAST] JUDGES

The Society introduced a ruling that Judges should retire from the Judges Panel at 75 years of age. There is a waiver for Council to appoint an Emeritus Judge at their discretion.

Emeritus Judges may retire from the panel at their own request.

TRAINEE JUDGES

Trainees should achieve the following prior to being considered and assess for listing on the Judges Panel.

Accompany Herd Competition Judges for at least two years covering at least five days of judging of different competition classes.

Attend events hosted by the Society where cattle are assessed for breeding standards.

Attend events arranged by the Society when judging assessments of Trainees are made.

PROBATIONARY JUDGES

Probationary Judges are newly qualified Judges that will undergo a probationary period of 2 years before Council consider them for the Judges Panel. During this time they will be invited to Judge the Herd Competition and other appointments as selected by Council.

It is advised that Probationary Judges continue to attend Trainee and other Judging events organised by the Society, also to accompany Herd Judges.

HERD COMPETITON JUDGES

All judges listed are eligible for selection by Council for judging the Herd Competition.

Note: Some Judges have elected to only judge the Herd Competition.

Two members of the panel will judge each class.

The primary judge will make the judging arrangements.

The secondary judge will become the primary judge the following year.

Judges will not be selected from the same family/herd to judge a class.

Championship Class: Council will endeavour to select a judge from outside the breed although they may be on the Society's Judges Panel.

BULL INSPECTORS

Council will select Inspectors from the Judges Panel.

Inspectors should be selected from the Senior Judges list.

Inspections must not take place if both Inspectors are from the same family/herd.

A member of the Inspection Panel will be selected by Council and made co-ordinator to arrange inspections.

REGISTRATIONS

In January you will all be sent Herd Registration Capitation Forms. Please complete them and return to the Office by 31st March. We will then issue an invoice which will cover all female calf registration fees for the year and enter male calves on the database. This is important if you plan to register a young bull.

Birth Returns should be sent in at the end of each month through the online database accessed through our website. (Easiest to do it as you do your BCMS.) All calves male and female should be entered.

REGISTERING BULLS

Updated Rules and Regulations apply from 1st October so please use the correct forms from the website of apply to the Office to have them sent by email or post. We will not be accepting incorrect out of date forms.

DNA PARENTAGE TESTING

From 1st January 2021 all young bulls will be required to have DNA sampling taken, we advise that this be done by the vet when the veterinary inspection is being undertaken, if not samples will be taken by the Bull Inspectors, a DNA sample will also be taken from the Sire and Dam. The purpose of this is to establish the parentage of all bulls. This is a progressive plan and will eventually result in all bulls having their parentage proven. The Society will be paying for the Sire and Dam DNA sampling but it will be the breeder/owner of the young bull who will pay for that DNA sample and sire verification.

Note: It is requirement for all bulls that are selected for semen collection to have their parentage proven through DNA testing.

CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP

Offspring are not eligible for registration if the sire and/or dam have not been transferred to your herd.

These are now late, please send in through the online system. (We do still accept paper birth returns at present but if you can do it online please do.)
