## AGM 2026

The AGM will be held on Thursday, 23rd April at the Sussex Ox.

By kind invitation of Mr. Stephen Carr. A “Sussex Dinner” is also going to be arranged following after the AGM. We hope as many of you as possible will attend. More information will be sent out nearer the date.

### **CHANGE TO REGISTRATION RULES GRADE A Breed Development.**

Council have become aware that over time due to various factors the Breed Percentages in some Development Grades have become reduced. Due to the ability of the new database programme to calculate Breed Percentages with some accuracy the decision has been made to improve the Breed Percentage across all Grades and the Full Herd Book status. This will involve staged amendments to the rules to allow breeders to make informed decisions prior to bull selection for their females and in replacement heifer selection. We hope that you will understand that these new rules are for the benefit of the breed as a whole and to give greater clarity in breeding programmes.

**From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2027 Grade A registrations must have a Breed Percentage of a minimum 50% or above to be accepted for entry in the Herd Book. Those below 50% would be held in a sub-category and their offspring may become eligible in the future on achieving 50% Breed Percentage.**

### **HERD BOOK VOLUME 129**

This covers registrations of births in 2024 and other earlier registration years for bulls and late registrations. There are a few spare copies and these are free to breeders on request.

The Herd Book has been sent out to all who requested a copy. The print format has been changed this year as with such a limited number of copies being required costs had spiralled. We hope you will all understand the reason why Council made this decision.

### **PAINTING**

The Painting sold successfully at the auction on 15th October for £5,500 well above the reserve and guide price.

We do not know who made the purchase.



## TIDY UP YOUR HERD RECORDS

We would very much like to keep the Database information up to date, especially before the hand over to Pedigree Livestock Services next year.

This is very simple to do by logging into the Society's Database and you can then opt to look at the list of animals in your herd. You will see a list of animals allocated to your ownership. You can then mark as sold or dead, whichever applies. The removed animals will remain on the Society's Database but be removed from your herd information.

If you would like any help on how to do this, please contact the Office and I will talk you through the procedure and give you log-in information if you do not have it.



Footnote  
Sussex Cattle, the breed that is native to the South East of England, became very popular in the early 1800's as an early maturing beef breed, and so numerous were the herds that the most progressive breeders felt the time had come to found a Breed Society and to publish a Herd Book.

Thus, on 18th November, 1878, a public meeting, was held at The King's Head, Horsham, for the purpose of considering and promoting the future management of the Sussex Herd and The Sussex Herd Book Society was formed for promoting the breed of Sussex Cattle.

In June 1879, the first volume of the Herd Book was published, containing entries of Sussex Cattle from 1855 to 1875. It contained the names of breeders and the pedigrees of their animals and the prizes they had won. Almost 150 years later the annual herd book is still published by The Sussex Cattle Society and the breed continues to be very popular in the South East.

# **REGISTRATIONS**

In January you were sent Herd Registration Capitation Forms. Please complete them and return to the Office by 31st March. We will then issue an invoice which will cover all female calf registration fees for the year and enter male calves on the database. This is important if you plan to register a young bull.

Birth Returns should be sent in at the end of each month through the online database accessed through our website. (Easiest to do it as you do your BCMS.) All calves male and female should be entered.

## **REGISTERING BULLS**

Updated Rules and Regulations apply from 1st October 2024 so please use the correct forms from the website of apply to the Office to have them sent by email or post. We will not be accepting incorrect out of date forms.

## **DNA PARENTAGE TESTING**

From 1st January 2021 all young bulls will be required to have DNA sampling taken, we advise that this be done by the vet when the veterinary inspection is being undertaken, if not samples will be taken by the Bull Inspectors, a DNA sample will also be taken from the Sire and Dam. The purpose of this is to establish the parentage of all bulls. This is a progressive plan and will eventually result in all bulls having their parentage proven. The Society will be paying for the Sire and Dam DNA sampling but it will be the breeder/owner of the young bull who will pay for that DNA sample and sire verification.

Note: It is requirement for all bulls that are selected for semen collection to have their parentage proven through DNA testing.

## **CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP**

Offspring are not eligible for registration if the sire and/or dam have not been transferred to your herd.
