General Health – is the bull in good health to the best of your knowledge on date of inspection			
Mouth/Jaw Setting - Correct dentition, do the teeth make proper contact with the dental pad of the upper jaw?			
Eyes – is there any evidence of cataract or microphthalmia?			
Heart – are there any signs of heart damage/failure to function correctly?			
Lungs - are there any signs of lung damage/failure to function correctly?			
Legs – are there any signs of abnormal positioning or gait?			
Feet – are there any signs of abnormal positioning or badly formed/cracked hooves			
Testicles – are the testicles of equal size with normal conformation and consistency for this age of bull?			
Scrotal Measurement - Mandatory Measurement in centimetres of the circumference of the testicles at the widest part of the scrotum is:			cms
